SACHI operates student dormitories to maximize your study abroad experience. Apartments and shared houses within biking distance ensure you don't spend too much time commuting.

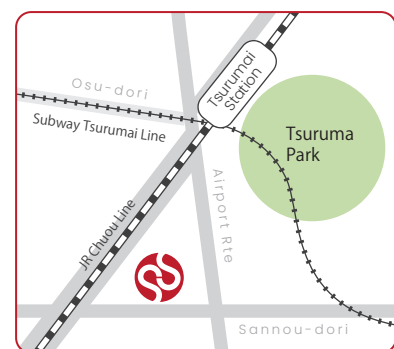

## Study Abroad Course Scheduled to Begin in April 2026

Our school is currently in the process of applying for certification from the Ministry of Education, Culture, Sports, Science, and Technology (MEXT) to accept international students starting in April 2026. The final decision on the approval is expected by the end of October 2025. If we do not receive certification, students will not be able to obtain a student visa for the purpose of studying Japanese at our school, and entry into Japan will not be permitted. We kindly ask prospective students to take this into consideration when planning their studies abroad. Updates on the application process and results will be provided on our website as needed.

## FEATURES Educational Features

01 Developing communication skills and fundamental competencies essential for thriving in society.

At SACHI, in addition to skill-specific classes, students learn career Japanese and project-based subjects. These classes include practical communication activities such as interviewing professionals working in various companies. We also incorporate computer skills training in Japanese and understanding Japanese corporate culture into our curriculum, providing programs that ensure a smooth transition to the next step after graduation.

02 Developing Japanese language proficiency (B2 level) to participate in and negotiate during business meetings.

The B2 level Japanese proficiency (equivalent to JLPT N2~N1) that SACHI aims for enables students to participate in and negotiate during business meetings. By studying diligently at SACHI, students can leverage their expertise gained in their home countries and build their careers in Japan.

03 Educational Support with a Focus on Post-Graduation Careers

At SACHI, we incorporate visitor sessions with professionals and networking events with companies into the curriculum starting from the first year. Faculty and staff provide support to help students realize their envisioned "unique career paths."

Japanese B2 Two-Year Course for Career Development

In our two-year study abroad course, students will develop Japanese communication skills from A1 level (equivalent to JLPT N5) to B2 level (above JLPT N2). You will acquire a balanced proficiency in the necessary abilities for thriving in Japanese society, including "speaking (interaction and presentation), listening, reading, writing," and "computer skills in Japanese."

Classes are held either in the morning or in the afternoon. There are no classes on weekends and public holidays.

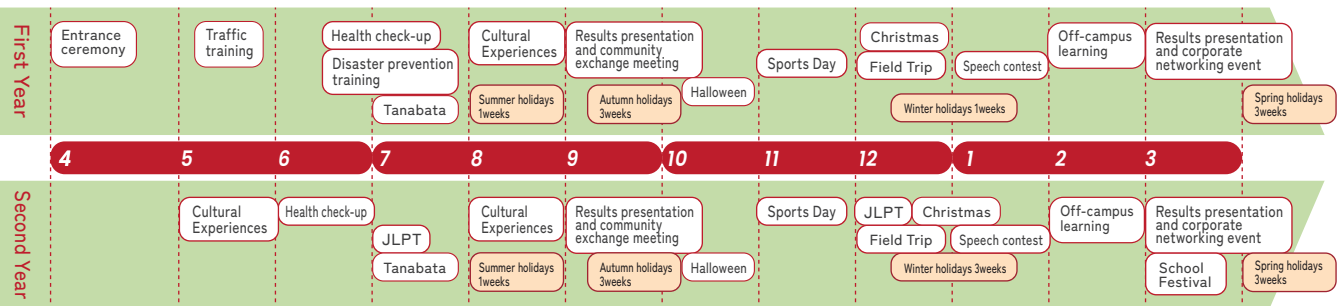
## LOCATION Surrounding Environment of SACHI
