### Study Abroad Course Scheduled to Begin in April 2026

Our school is currently in the process of applying for certification from the Ministry of Education, Culture, Sports, Science, and Technology (MEXT) to accept international students starting in April 2026. The final decision on the approval is expected by the end of October 2025. If we do not receive certification, students will not be able to obtain a student visa for the purpose of studying Japanese at our school, and entry into Japan will not be permitted.We kindly ask prospective students to take this into consideration when planning their studies abroad. 




Located near the lush Tsuruma Park and the Nagoya City Library, with convenient access to downtown areas such as Sakae. offering an ideal learning environment.


